

Conestogo Wind Energy Centre Community Liaison Committee (CLC)

Conestogo Wind, LP ("Company"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of NextEra Energy Canada, ULC will be **forming a Community Liaison Committee ("CLC")** as a forum to exchange ideas, share information and provide regular updates as the Conestogo Wind Energy Centre ("Facility") progresses through construction and the first year of operation.

The CLC is intended to facilitate two-way communications between the Company and members of the public on issues or concerns related to the construction, installation, use, operation, maintenance and retirement of the Facility. IBI Group has been retained to act as a coordinator and facilitator of the CLC meetings.

A range of stakeholders are being sought to join the CLC (e.g. persons residing within 1 km of the Facility, other area residents and landowners, members of the agricultural and business community, government agencies, local organizations, special interest groups, etc.). While the CLC will be limited to 14 members, meetings will be open (for observation) to the general public and all CLC materials will be available for review.

CLC members will be responsible for attending four (4) meetings over a two-year period (i.e. 2 annually). The meetings will take place on a weekday evening and last approximately 2 hours. CLC members will be encouraged to help relay information to and from other members of the community.

If you are interested in joining the CLC, please submit a request to participate (in writing) to Amy Shepherd at IBI Group by March 9th, 2012. IBI Group will then provide additional information on the next steps for the CLC membership selection process.
